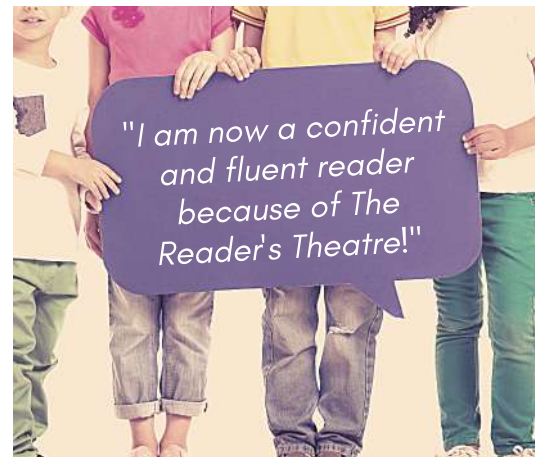

PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

Led by an experienced television reporter and programme producer who has worked with leading international broadcasters from BBC and Bloomberg to National Geographic and Discovery Channel, your child will become a little reporter, developing verbal fluency, expressiveness, and self-confidence!

Session 1: Your child will practise speaking with carefully selected articles, focusing on diction and pronunciation.

Session 2: Your child will learn how to write a story and tell a story. Story-telling is a great way to improve communication and literacy!

Session 3: Your child will learn how to conduct an interview – how to phrase a question and how to answer a question.

Session 4: Your child will learn how to speak with confidence in front of the audience and the camera. Your child will also have an opportunity to learn how to be a good cameraman!

Parents will receive videos of their child's "reporting" after each session!

1) INTRODUCTION TO VIOLIN

- For those who would like to start learning the violin. No prior experience required.

#1 Keyboard Technique as a Foundation

Aside from learning the instrument of choice, all Beginners Level classes of the regular Cedar Music Advancement Programme include the instruction of basic keyboard technique on the piano. Cedar believes it is important for every child who wants to learn an instrument to receive basic keyboard technique training because it lays an important foundation and facilitates learning of other instruments. Basic keyboard technique helps a child learn to read music, develop a sense of pitch and dynamics and understand music theory.

When children learn and play as a group, they inspire and motivate each other. Peer learning allows children to learn faster while they also learn how to cooperate with and respect one another.

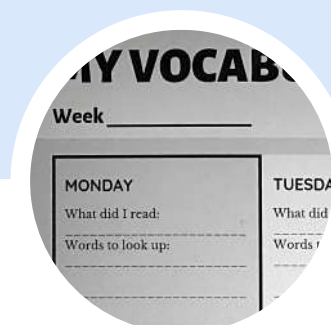
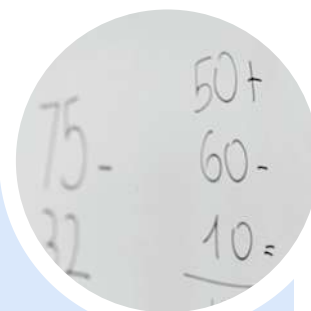
